That high-five worthy moment after hours of casting is justified when, finally, you spot a fish in the cold autumn water. A once lethargic brown trout is now hooked on your fly, twisting and pulling. You reel her in and take note of how well she blends in with her underwater habitat. Sight fishing is all about a good pair of shades like the Revo Heading.

Revo's polarized Green Water lenses block 100 percent of harmful UV rays and absorb 87 percent of visual light. This means you've got an all-around good pair of sunglasses for everything from driving to your secret honey hole to spotting a camouflaged fish in murky river water.

The best part about these shades is the fit. The Heading frames are built with a spring hinge, so they're snug and comfortable while you're treading through swift current, or pulling in that catch.

Ronan GTX Mid boots

The Ronan GTX is one of Lowa's sturdiest mid-range boots, even with its lighter weight at 2.5 lbs per pair. It's much more durable than true lightweights, stays drier in wet conditions, and provides great support - they were sufficient while hiking the hummocks in northern Alaska's Arctic National Wildlife Refuge last summer. With warm socks, you could hunt in these boots all season. Sporting Lowa's stable PU Monowrap frame and a Vibram sole, I'd choose the Ronan over any lightweight boot on the market. - Rick Bass \$245

Cool kids with a conscience are behind Shwood's Canby Pendleton sunglasses. They're crafted in Oregon - home to large trees and warm Pendleton blankets but are suitable for Montana, home of Big Sky and plentiful sunshine.

An artisan ethos pulls together the retro-mod style of the Canby with FSC-certified, sustainably harvested wood and laser-engraved signature Pendleton pattern. The featherweight frames, comfortable fit and polarized lenses are an added bonus, since we all know that fashion trumps function when it comes to sunglasses. With five color choices all complete with a funky wool case, these limited edition sunglasses are an aesthetic accessory to anyone's stocking this holiday season. Sperry Top-Sider Winter Cove Boots

One of the great things about Sperry's Winter Cove Boots is they don't feel like boots at all. While most winter treads tend to be clunky and heavy, Sperry has found a way to make them so lightweight and comfortable you barely notice you're wearing them.

Sperry integrated their adaptive Wave-Sipping technology on the mini-lug sole, which provides great traction and little slippage on streets and trails. The Winter Coves also

keep my feet at a comfortable temperature both indoors and out - warm but not too hot - and they stayed dry while tromping through early-season slush and snow with my dogs.

For a touch of style, the boots also have brightly colored laces, quilted side panels and faux fur that's not too fluffy, so they look great with skirts, pants, tights and everything in between. Available in linen, black and white. - Megan Paulson \$130

The new Nano-Air Hoody from Patagonia is a breakthrough in technical apparel. The warm, stretchy and breathable FullRange insulation regulates your temperature while playing in the outdoors like no other jacket I've worn. It insulates like a down jacket until you get moving – that's when the FullRange technology takes over. Instead of peeling off and putting layers on all day you can stick with the Nano-Air and focus on the task at hand.

I used this piece while belaying a rock climb in the Gallatin Canyon on a warm, windy early November day; wore it on a run both up and down Mount Baldy northeast of Bozeman; and threw it on over my ski jacket during a -10 F early season ski day in the northern Bridgers.





The Landlord features S-Rocker for float and speed, extending from the nose to your lead foot, then transitioning to camber between your feet. In addition, the Superfly II core uses lightweight wood that targets strategic areas to drop weight and increase pop. The Landlord also features Burton' exclusive infinite-ride technology, which essentially breaks in the board before you buy it to ensure it maintains its feel for seasons to come.

The women's specific Anti-Social board offers all of the above features in a women's specific shape, in a 150-cm length.

Skevik Anton skis

Skevik has been expertly engineering and handcrafting skis in Vernon, British Columbia since 2010. Throughout the last five years its lineup has more than doubled, but one of the original models, the Anton, stands the test of time and continues to stake its claim as Skevik's flagship ski.

Named in honor of the owner's great grandfather, Anton Skevik, the ski features maple sidewalls and comes with the buyer's choice of five available graphics, all created by hard-working, local artists. The skis are stylish but all that flash, as you'll discover, plays second fiddle to function.

At 122 mm underfoot the Anton's float will never be questioned and they destroy deep snow. However, the ski's sidecut, tapered tip, rocker, and camber give the Anton an unmatched versatility in handling all conditions. This makes it a perfect selection both on the ski hill and off, and in the unpredictable wilds of the backcountry. Pillows, tight couloirs and everything in between, the Anton can take it all in and deliver.

The Canadian dollar is riding a little lower than previous years, making this deal just that much sweeter.

When it's time to head from the parking lot to the mountain, the Dakine Deluxe Cargo Pack 55L boot bag helps you transport your ski or snowboard boots with ease. Thanks to a tarp-lined compartment and compression straps, your boots will be safe and secure inside this durable and reliable pack.

The DLX Cargo even has A-frame ski- and vertical snowboard-carry option as well, if you decide to head into the backcountry for some untouched powder. The shoulder straps are stashable, and the pack has a helmet pocket that secures your most important piece of gear.

Ultra-lightweight at just 2.6 pounds, you won't be bogged down with unnecessary weight when hauling your essential gear to the hill.

Think of Black Diamond's Spark as the classic, work-glove style you see worn by patrollers, lifties, and dirtbags – then mix in professional athlete consultation, BD's minimalist design, full goat-leather construction, 100 percent waterproof BDry inserts, a neoprene cuff and Velcro closure.

The Spark makes it practical for your human- or lift-powered ascents,

while staying warm and dry during pow-filled descents. Tricot lined inside with 60g PrimaLoft insulation makes your hand feel like it's surrounded by pillows, so you're dry and comfortable whether you're shoveling your driveway or charging lines off the Headwaters. The Spark comes in several flashy color options to match your tastes, and break away from the pale-yellow, work-glove monotony.

Dakine Deluxe Tune Kit

Nothing gets you quite as amped to shred as tuning up your snowboard for the first time of the season. The Dakine Deluxe Tune Kit has everything you need except for the iron and a base-cleaning solution. Find a household cleaner like Simple Green and a \$5 thrift shop iron: check.

First step, sharpen your edges with the edge-tuning tool, and then use the included pocket stone to get rid of any nasty burrs leftover from last spring's rock and slush season. Second, clean that base to make a fresh surface for your wax.

Got core shots? This kit has you covered with two kinds of P-Tex – you can use the clear, but black looks cooler against colored bases. The metal scraper works great for smoothing out your repair job. Finally, apply wax evenly, let cool, scrape, and use the scuff pad to wipe your base smooth. Then, go shred.

Contour Roam 3 POV Waterproof HD Action Cam



The world of point of view (POV) video has taken the camera arena by storm, and the all-new Roam 3 by Contour has proven to be one of the leaders in action camera technology.

With convenience and ease of use in mind, the Contour Roam 3 packs in all the techy specs you would expect in a high-end action cam, but is functional with the flip of a switch. No menus, and no wondering if the camera is actually on: Slide the "Instant-on" switch and you're recording in crystal clear 1080p at 30 frames per second, or 720p at 60 fps. Want to take photos? Alternate from video to photo mode with ease, and fire off five-megapixel photos with the push of a button.

The Roam 3's rugged design is sure to handle a beating. This camera is not only waterproof to 30 feet without a waterproof housing, but also shockproof if you take a hard digger on land.

This camera is a great way to get into the POV world, and it's half the price of many of its competitors. One drawback is that to change video frame rates you must connect to a computer and use the software Contour provides, which is tough when you're out adventuring. However, the waterproof, rugged design and long-lasting battery make up for it. - Brian Niles \$199

A solid guidebook is an indispensable resource for discovering new terrain in the mountains. The Bozeman and Big Sky Backcountry Ski Guide fills this role nicely for recent imports and seasoned southwest Montana backcountry skiers alike. Author Ben Werner lists all the area classics like Mount Blackmore south of Bozeman, Yellow Mountain in Big Sky and "The Fin" on Mount Republic in Cooke City.

You'll also find some lesser-trafficked gems like the "Bacon Rind Skillet"

in Yellowstone National Park. Each ski destination listed features a map with approach and descent routes, as well as detailed descriptions of the area. You'll find total elevation gain, skiable vertical, slope aspect, and amount of skier traffic you'll likely encounter.




Ace Hardware Tuffy Shovel


